About the Festival

Limitless Festival has one main venue for 11-17 year olds and one main venue for 18-30 year olds, as well as a packed activity schedule featuring sports, seminars, cafes and after-hours venues. With thousands of young people, we will spend time worshipping God and learning about Him. There'll be loads of other fun activities too.

About our camp

We camp together, providing accommodation and food for the 5 days. If you are planning to bring a tent, let me know, but we have some as well as a marquee that is our living area/dining hall.

Money

A ticket to Limitless Festival costs **£81 before 29th February** (early bird discount)

If you book between 1st March and 30th April it costs £91, and £96 thereafter.

There is also a 2% booking fee (£4.02 before 29th Feb)

We then charge **£30 per person** to cover the costs of food, camping gas and other expenses. You do not need to buy any camping equipment: we will provide it. A sleeping bag and airbed would be helpful, though we do have spares.

So in total, the trip should cost you £115 per person, if you book early enough. If you want to come, but cannot afford the cost, please speak to us ***as early as possible***.

Free places are available to anyone who volunteers on one of the *Limitless* teams.

How to book

If you are under 18, you must have parent/guardian's consent before booking. You will not be able to attend without consent, and we cannot guarantee a refund once booked.

You can book your ticket online at the website address above. You may need to register with SolidRock Events Management.

To be added to our group, you will be asked for a Unique Code. It is **cfitr**tb**2as** (case sensitive).

If you are unable to book online, please contact me and I will book for you, on receipt of the correct cash/bank transfer.

Please contact me once you have booked so that I can check you have been correctly added to our camping group (as this is the first time attending this Festival, I want to double check everything!)

What happens then?

Nearer the time (May-June) I will send out a "Final Arrangements" letter to everyone who is booked on. This includes parental consent (for U18s), a kit list, medical and emergency contact form, some more info about travel and arrival/departure times.
