

Two Poems based on John 20:19-end from Scripture Union's "Bubbles"

Is it Jesus? © Scripture Union

(You could use two fingers or two puppets to represent the different voices)

'Is it Jesus? Is it true?'

'Listen and look - I'm speaking to you.'

'Is it Jesus? Are you real?'

'See my hands and have a feel.'

'Is it Jesus? Or is it a wish?'

'Watch me - I will eat some fish.'

'Now do you think it is really true?'

'Yes, you're alive! It really is you!'

Two little eyes © Scripture Union

(You and your child could point to different body parts)

Two little eyes to see him there.

Two little ears to hear him care.

Two little feet to walk towards him.

Two little hands to feel his skin.

Two little eyes to watch him eat.

Jesus is real from head to feet!

An activity to do: Is Jesus real and alive?

Try these tests on you, your child and a teddy to see if they are alive and real.

- Can you breathe? Hold hand or mirror in front of nose and mouth
- Can you move? Try jumping, walking, moving arms and wiggling fingers
- Can you talk? Try saying something to each other
- Can you eat and drink? Try eating and drinking something
- Are you warm and solid? Feel your skin

Hopefully you will conclude that you and your child are alive, but the teddy isn't!

Now look at John 20:19-31 and Luke 24:36-49.

Do these tests prove Jesus is real and alive?
