Today's aim is to discover that God is powerful and to explore our response to him.
Matthew 15:32-39

This Bible story is similar to Mathew 14:13-21.

Here, Jesus feeds a crowd of 4,000 men – plus women and children – and he does so with seven pieces of bread and a few fish. Repeating such an action may simply show that Jesus could do this sort of thing whenever he needed to; or it may have been to show God's power in a wide geographical area. Jesus demonstrates his creative power by taking something small and multiplying it.

Feeding the people points to the power of God at work in Jesus.

God made the universe from nothing. The Bible story shows that Jesus has the same power. Wow!
