

Family Worship at Home!

Here are some activities you could do at home. Start with the story and then do as many or as few as you like.

Bible passage

Read the story of Jesus' BBQ on the beach. You will find it in most children's Bibles or you could read it in John 21:1-14

It's very sunny as I write this, so maybe you could read the story whilst having a BBQ outside, but if it's starting snowing, why not go for fish fingers or tuna sandwiches instead!



Discussion

Questions for adults to ask children?

- Have you ever been fishing or had a BBQ? Did you like it?
- What would you do, if you were working or playing then turned around and saw Jesus?
- Why do you think Jesus made the disciples breakfast?

Questions for adults to ask children

- Have you ever been surprised at where you've found Jesus?

A prayer to pray together

Father God, help us to know you are always there, even when we are surprised to find you. Help us to share with others the goodness we find in you. Amen



An activity

Maybe you have a fishing game already that you could play. Or perhaps you could play a catching game, how many balls can you catch at once? Or even have a game of apple bobbing (they are better to catch with your mouth than fish are!)

A prayer Activity

Make a net. You could use string, ribbon, shoe laces even spaghetti!

The disciples caught 153 fish in today's story. Could you think of 153 people to pray for and write their names and place them in the net? Don't worry I couldn't!

Instead maybe think of:

1 thing in the world to pray about.

5 people to pray for

3 things to thank God for

Write or draw them, and place them in the net as a sign that God has caught them.

An activity


