And remember, Children's Church will resume on **13 September**.

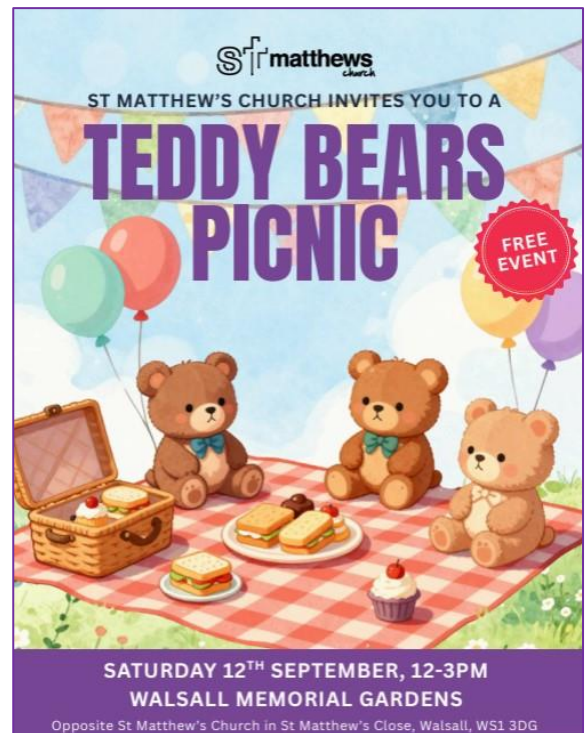
Heritage events
